

ATTENTION EMPLOYEES

This employer reports your wages to the Texas Employment Commission. If you become unemployed, you may be eligible for unemployment benefit payments.

The Texas Payday Law, Article 5155, revised statutes, requires Texas employers to pay their employees who are exempt from the overtime pay provisions of Fair Standards Act of 1938 at least once per month. All other employees must be paid at least as often as semimonthly, and each pay period must consist as nearly as possible of an equal number of days.
